## Anti-doping Organization Anti-doping operating manual

The entire Anti-doping Organization is managed in compliance with the World Athletics Anti-doping Rules and WADA CODE 2021.

In agree with the NADO San Marino Anti-doping Rules 2021 the Authority is NADO San Marino.

In this document are fixed the implementation of the rules.

At the first the NADO San Marino fixed:

- 1) Chaperone and the DCO are by NADO San Marino.
- 2) An agreement with the F.M.S.I. (Italian Medical Sport Federation) all sample will be send to Rome Antidoping Laboratory directly by DCO.

All antidoping controls will be held at the Serravalle Stadium. Inside the stadium there are a room for women's controls and a room for men's controls (Referee dressing room).

The athletes will be accompanied directly on foot by the chaperone to the doping control station.

## Test distribution plan

The test distribution plan is managed in compliance with the WADA international standard "Testing and Investigations January 2021".

Will be carried, almost exclusively test in competition and only testing of urine.

Anybody should know in advance notice about test., will be checked the winner or medalist or finalist.

Furthermore will be controlled the athletes who will make the world record or European record.

The antidoping organization will accept the request from athletes who will want to undergo voluntary control.

The athletes must immediately report his will to the doping control committee at the doping control station.

In this case the cost of the control sample, 500,00 Euros, will be borne by the athletes or the Olympic committee of the athlete.

Persons authorized to be present at the control room:

- (A) a representative and / or an interpreter where required by the athlete
- (B) a representative in the case of minors
- C) there may be an observer sent by WADA, who can not directly observe the production of urine.
